IRS Form 990 is an annual reporting return required by the IRS for certain federally tax exempt organizations and includes information about the organization mission, programs and finances.

For Camp Secretaries. <u>If your fiscal year ended December 31, 2012.</u> <u>IRS form #990</u> <u>is Due by May 15<sup>th</sup>.</u> (Failure to submit this report could result in the revocation of your Camp, Tax Exempt status). IRS form # 990 EZ can be filed electronically. Any questions contact
