1. All Brothers planning on utilizing Video for the Encampment:
 1. The following computer operating systems are compatible:
 1. Windows – go to Zoom.us to access Zoom or follow the link sent to you, after registration
 2. Ios (This is Macintosh/Apple) – go to Zoom.us or follow the link sent to you after registration
 2. The following Tablet operating systems are compatible:
 1. Macintosh – go to the Apple store and download the official ZOOM app
 2. Android – go to the PLAY store and download the official ZOOM app
 3. Windows – go to Zoom.us to access Zoom or follow the link sent to you, after registration
 3. The following Smart Phone systems are compatible:
 1. Apple – go to the Apple store and download the official ZOOM app
 2. Android – go to the PLAY store and download the official ZOOM app
 4. Insure your computer is working and you have high speed internet, dial-up internet is not compatible
 5. Be prepared to sign in and have to wait to be admitted to the Encampment. As we continue to work with this technology, we will continue to update the process.
2. All Brothers who will attend by Voice only.
 1. You will be given a telephone number and a passcode to enter the Encampment.
 2. The Voice only feature will work with a landline, if you have touch-tone capabilities.
 3. The Voice only feature will also work with a cellular phone.
 4. The telephone number may be from outside your local dial area.
