RE: Memorial Day 2025

Whereas, this being the 157th year since General John Logan called for a national day of remembrance for Civil war dead and issued his General Order No. 11 instituting the observance of Memorial Day on May 30th.

By the authority vested in me as Commander, Department of Michigan, Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War, it is hereby ordered as follows:

- 1.I hereby call all Brothers and Camps, to observance of Memorial Day, bothe the observed on Monday, May 26th, and the TRUE Memorial Day on Friday, May 30th.
- 2. I ask that all Brothers participate in this observance, not only through our activities, but also by actively reminding others of the REAL reason we commemorate this day. Remember this is not a celebration but a remembrance.
